Purpose – Provide a venue to honor military service while allowing competition for title and prize money.

Eligibility – Open to all current USBC certified members. If not already a 2024/2025 certified member, membership may be purchased on site. Failure to do so prior to the first ball of competition will result in disqualification of individual scores.

Teams – must include at least 2 players with a military background and a maximum of 2 guests bowling 3 games each.

Doubles/Singles - each pair includes at least 1 player with a military background bowling 6 games each. Must bowl both Doubles and Singles events.

All-Events - Optional individual Handicap and/or Scratch for an additional \$10 entry fee each. Fee must be paid prior to bowling any event.

Military ID Requirements – Players who are bowling as military background player must present proof of military service. (Active-Duty Military ID, VA ID, Veterans ID, Veterans designation on driver's license, etc.)

Handicap – Handicap based on 90% of 220 (220 and higher bowl scratch, no negative handicap). Players without a certified average must bowl scratch. Players use their handicap for each event. Teammates add their handicaps together for a team handicap. Doubles add individual handicaps together for doubles handicap.

Averages – Players use their USBC league composite average of at least 21 games from 2023/24 season. If no 2023/24 average available, USBC league composite average of at least 21 games from 2022/23 season will be used. If no certified USBC average of 21 games is available a 220 average will apply. Averages may be subject to re-rating per tournament director should any player's performance indicate ability that is deemed to be significantly above entering average.

USBC rule 319d and 319e WILL APPLY. USBC rule 201c, sport rule WILL APPLY.

Deadline - is September 19, 2024. Entries will be accepted after deadline as space permits.

Playing Rules – Rules of the Mesa Metro Military Classic stated herein, and those of the USBC will govern all participants. The tournament director(s) will have the right to resolve all questions and disputes. All decisions shall be final and binding.

General – Entrants can bowl on multiple teams with at least 2 roster changes. It is the Team Captain's responsibility to find substitutes if needed. **Substitutes** must be submitted to the tournament director at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled squad time. Optional all-events fees may be transferred to a substitute only if the substitute replaces the original entrant in all entered events prior to participation in any event by either participant. In case of disability after a game has started in the team and doubles events, a substitute will be allowed if one is available and meets criteria required for position on team/doubles (i.e., military status or guest). Tournament director(s) must approve any roster changes.

Dress Code – Attire must be neat, clean, and properly fitting. Slacks jeans, dress shorts, skorts, and skirts of at least mid-thigh length will be allowed. Shirts/blouses that not tucked in must be at least hip length. Clothing that advertises or depicts foul language or gestures will not be permitted. Tournament director(s) or designee's decision as to the appropriateness of attire will be final.

Returned checks – Any check in payment of entry fees for the tournament, returned for non-payment, will be assessed a service charge of \$40.00. Payment must be cleared prior to bowling.

Tournament and/or Association management reserves the right to cancel any tournament and/or squad, due to lack of entries/participation, by the closing date of the tournament, or as deemed necessary. All entries with fees would be returned to the team captains.

The current USBC Book of Rules shall govern any rule not covered above.
